 - Cash Flow




Mitigating Strategies

- Central Intake & Eligibility
- Additional medical complexity
- Physician team fully staffed
- Assessing compensation strategy
- Medicaid Small Facility Agreement







- Central intake process began mid-2017 significant impact on census
- Adding eligibility assistance May 2019 to combat lag in Medicaid eligibility
- New Administrator starts 5.28.19
- Providence is not collecting interest on outstanding liability



Ongoing Challenges

- Medicaid authorization & eligibility
- Medicaid budget uncertainty
- Capital Availability
